

Ass. Prof. Agnieszka Beata Serwin graduated Medical University in Bialystok in 1991. She obtained her speciality in dermatology –venereology in 2000. Since 1996 she works at the Department of Dermatology and Venereology of Medical University of Bialystok, Poland at present as a consulting doctor and academic teacher. Her PhD dissertation was defended in 1999 and she became associate professor in 2008. She published 45 papers in PubMed, is an author of several chapters in medical handbooks and was co-editor in the second polish edition of 'Braun Falco Dermatology'. In years 2012-2019 she was a chair, and now vice-chair of the section of venereology of Polish Dermatological Society. Since 2013 she is a national representative of Poland in International Union against Sexually Transmitted Infections Europe.
