He holds a PhD in Medicine (2016) and did postdoctoral fellowships at Chelsea and Westminster Hospital (Anton Pozniak, London, UK) and in molecular virology (prof.dr. Charles Boucher). His research group focuses on HIV cure, care cascade optimization, and COVID-HIV interactions. He has a strong research collaboration with Ukraine (Dr. Marta Vasylyev, Lviv) and initiated the aware.hiv Ukraine support initiative (www.awarehiv.com/ukraine) with EACS. He is PI at Erasmus MC HIV Eradication Group (EHEG), NL4Cure and EU2Cure consortia. In co-creation with PWH and data scientists, he started the #aware.hiv initiative to innovate HIV cascade of cares (inter)nationally. He is scientific committee member of EACS' Young Investigators (YING) and chairs the YING Innovation Platform (YIP) to connect young European HIV scientists.
