Dr Workowski serves as consultant to CDC assisting in the development of the Sexually Transmitted Infections Treatment Guidelines. She is a member of the HIV Prevention and Opportunistic Infection Guidelines panel, the AASLD/ IDSA Hepatitis C guidelines panel, and serves on the sexually transmitted infections scientific advisory council of the Infectious Diseases Clinical Research Consortium. Her current research interests include the pathogenesis and clinical management of sexually transmitted infections, the immunological aspects of hepatitis C persistence, novel therapeutic clinical trials (HIV, hepatitis C, PrEP), and antimicrobial resistance (*T vaginalis*, *N gonorrhoeae*).
